Submissions

After determining that your human subjects research study requires review by the UCSF IRB [1], submit the new study [2] using iRIS, our online submission system. [3]

As your study progresses, submit the following to IRB, as needed:

- Modifications [4] to your study, which must be approved by IRB before they are implemented,
- Continuing Review [5], which is much like a progress report,
- Protocol Enrollment Exception [6], for enrolling a single individual who does not meet the study entry criteria,
- Adverse Events [7], Protocol Violations or Incidents [8] and Other Types of Safety Information [7] that meet reporting criteria, and
 - Outcome Letters [9]
- Study Closeout Report [10] when the study is finished.
